CALIFORNIA CONSUMER PRIVACY STATEMENT

Last Updated: August 1, 2024

This California Consumer Privacy Statement supplements the TPG Website Privacy Policy and applies solely to California consumers, including but not limited to, representatives of our institutional investors, vendors and business partners, and individuals who act as our contractors, advisors, and consultants.

This Statement does not apply to TPG employees, owners, officers, directors (ii) job applicants seeking opportunities at TPG, or (iii) information collected, processed, sold or disclosed pursuant to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (and its implementing regulations) or the California Financial Information Privacy Act.

This California Consumer Privacy Statement (the "Statement") uses certain terms that have the meaning given to them in the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2020 (as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act of 2020) and its implementing regulations collectively, the "CCPA/CPRA".

1. Notice of Collection and Use of Personal Information

We may collect (and may have collected during the 12-month period prior to the effective date of this Statement) the following categories of personal information about you online or offline

- x Identifiers: identifiers such as a real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier (such as a device identifier including time zone setting and location and operating system and platform cookies, beacons, and pixel tags, unique pseudonym or user alias; telephone number), online identifier, internet protocol address, login data, email address, account name, Social Security number, driver's license number, passport number, date of birth, spouse's name, and other similar identifiers
- x Additional Data Subject to Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80: signature, physical characteristics or description, state identification card number, education, bank account number, credit card number, debit card number and other financial information, and medical information
- x Protected Classifications: characteristics of protected classifications under California or federal law, such as race, color, national origin, age, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, marital status, ancestry, religion, ethnicity, and national origin, and other characteristics defined in California Civil Code sections 52.9 (a) through 52.9 (j), and the California Fair Employment and Housing Act, including but not limited to, browser plug-ins and versions

- x Sensory Information: audio, electronic, visual, and similar information
- x Employment Information: professional employment-related information such as information relating to your job position (e.g., job title, job description and office location) and, if you are an advisor or consultant to TPG, additional information such as compensation and payroll details (e.g., bank account details, information relating to personal investments and tax-related information), talent management information e.g.

our office equipment, facilities, and other property and satisfying our legal and compliance obligations. We may also use your personal information in connection with our marketing efforts

We do not collect or process sensitive personal information for purposes of inferring characteristics about consumers.

## 2. Retention of Personal Information

TPG retains your personal information for the period reasonably necessary to achieve the purposes outlined in our Website Privacy Policy and this Statement, or any other notice provided at the time of collection, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by applicable law, taking into account relevant statutes of limitations and TPG's records retention requirements and policies

We may obtain (and may have obtained during the 12 month period prior to the effective date of this Statement) personal information about you from the following sources:

- x From you, including your devices or equipment, such as mobile devices, computers, tablets, smartphones, and other devices, and from our website, mobile application, and other digital products.
